

FISH CARE - Always use tackle which is up to the job - use a rod of sufficient strength when carp and pike fishing and at least 12lb breaking strain line. For pike fishing use a 24" wire uptrace, a 15" wire trace and semi-barbed hooks.

Use a substantial landing net - min. 36" - for pike and carp. Use an unhooking mat for all large fish. For coarse fish use barbless or whisker-barbed hooks.

Fish should always be handled carefully and handling should be kept to a minimum. Use a soft wet cloth when holding fish and, if you must touch them, wet your hands first.

Never overcrowd keepnets or leave fish in keepnets for longer than a few hours, especially in warm weather. In hot weather it is best not to use keepnets at all. Carp must only be retained in 'Carp Approved' keepnets or specialist carp sacks. Pike must never be retained in keepnets. IMPORTANT - report any signs of pollution immediately to the Environment Agency (0800 807060) and subsequently to the Fishery Manager or a committee member.

Always drive slowly through lanes & farms. Always shut gates.

Litter is the biggest enemy - take all litter home. Remember discarded litter & tackle can be dangerous to farm animals and
